HALF DAY TOURS WITHIN CAIRO

Pyramids of Giza & Sphinx:

The Pyramids of Cheops, Chephren and Mycerinus were reckoned by the Greeks to be one of the seven wonders of the world. Cheops Pyramid is especially interested since its interior burial chambers are opened for the public. Not far from the Pyramids there is the Sphinx of Giza. Hawn from natural yellowish limestone and standing 65 feet high and 187 feet long. This unforgettable statue combines the head of a Pharaoh with a lion's body.

Memphis & Sakkara:

Memphis served as the capital of upper and lower Egypt some 5000 years ago during the first Dynasty, built a great, white walled palace and the Temple of Ptah here.

One of the most exciting historical and archaeological areas in all Egypt is Sakkara, situated about 12 miles south west of Cairo. The site is dominating by the famous step Pyramid to be built in ancient Egypt.

HALF DAY TOURS WITHIN CAIRO

Egyptian Museum:

The Egyptian Museum is the most important depository of Egyptian Antiquities anywhere in the World. It features articrafts from the Pharonic and Greco- Roman periods, including the celebrated mummies of ancient Egypt's Kings and Tut Ankh Amun treasures.

Approximately 10 min. drive by taxi from Conrad Hotel





Citadel & Khan El-Khalili:

Its construction was initiated in 1176 by Salah El Din and completed by Muhammad Ali Mamleluke Sultans and Turkish governors later on made it their residence, building Palaces and mosques within the Citadel walls. The tour will also include a visit to the famous Khan El Khalili Bazaar dating back to the late 14th century.

Approximately 20 min. drive by taxi from Conrad Hotel

Coptic Museum:

The famous Coptic Museum is built on the site of the Roman Fotress of Babylon, constructed about 30 B.C under Augustus and rebuilt in the time of Trajan. Inside there are the richest collection of Coptic art in the world. Approximately 30 min. drive by taxi from Conrad Hotel
