

- Age limit is 40 years.

QUALIFICATION

- At least master degree in internal medicine, tropical medicine or surgery.

LANGUAGE

- The nominee has to be able to give his talk during the course in English.

DEADLINE

- Only nominations received within the deadline can be accepted.

APPLICANTS ARE ASKED TO SUBMIT

- Curriculum vitae
- An Endoscopy case report (3 minutes video case presentations)
or Hepatology research abstract (maximum 300 words)



EMERGING STARS AWARD

SELECTION MECHANISM AND PROCEDURE

- A total of 10 trainees "5 video case presentations and 5 research abstracts" will be selected from the submitted material.
- Applications will be reviewed by Egypt Gastro Hep international faculty and will be based on criteria of academic excellence, intellectual curiosity and initiative.
- Applicants will be informed by October 31, 2011 whether their application has been accepted or not.
